February 10th	Ash Wednesday	Matthew 4:1-11	First day of 40 day Fast marked by the temptation of Christ discuss how Jesus defeated the devil with the Word of God
March 20th	Palm Sunday	Matthew 21:1-9	Triumphant Entry when Christ was first recognized as King
March 25th	Good Friday	Matthew 26:30 - Matthew 27:60	Betrayal, Trial, Suffering, & Death of Jesus - The price Jesus paid for our sins
March 27th	Easter	Matthew 28 all	Resurrection of Jesus: The Victory over Death, Hell, and the Grave
May 5th	Ascension	Acts 1 all	Promis of the Holy Spirit also read John 14:16-18 and John 14:26
May 15th	Pentecost	Acts 2 all	The Arrival of the Holy Spirit - the power of God came to dwell inside us
May 22nd	Trinity Sunday	1 John 5:7	There are 3 persons of God, Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Father is Creator and overseer, Jesus is the Word who came to Earth to save us, and the Holy Spirit is the power of God that is here with us on Earth and lives inside us
November 24th	Thanksgiving	1 Thessalonians 5:18	God gives us everything and we should always have an attitude of gratitude for all He does for us
November 27th	Advent	Luke 1 all & John 14:1-6	Advent means arrival. It is the celebration of the arrival of Christ. His first arrival His birth on Earth, and His second arrival still to come the rapture
December 25th	Christmas	Luke 2 all	The birth of Jesus. He came to Earth in the form of a man to because only a spotless man could pay the price for all mankind and make a new covenant with God
